- ★ **Literacy**—Letter recognition, letter sounds, reading readiness, listening, comprehension, beginning writing skills, sequencing, rhyming
- ★ **Religion**—Sign of the cross, simple prayers, God’s gifts, God’s love, religious holidays, character development through simple bible stories
- ★ **Math**— Counting, number sense, comparing size, shapes, graphing, patterns, sorting, matching, one-to-one correspondence
- ★ **Art** – Coloring, scissor skills, cutting, pasting, painting, crafts
- ★ **Science** – Colors, seasons, five senses, animals, nutrition, health, living and non-living things
- ★ **Social studies** – Family, school, community, life long ago, maps and globes, safety, holidays, transportation
- ★ **Music**— Singing, finger plays, musical instruments
- ★ **Dramatic Play** – Play allows children to discover, explore, and cooperate with others. Children have several opportunities for creative play. An Area in the classroom is specifically designed for dramatic play. New materials are added to this area each month to provide students with new learning experiences.
